










Posidonia Sustainability Pillars



Posidonia's event management system has been successfully certified according to the ISO 20121 main focus: the balanced approach & performance to Economic Activity, Environmental Responsibility and Social Progress.

Posidonia 2024 has received the ISO 20121 certification, confirming the company's commitment to organising sustainable events and underlining the Greek exhibition industry's commitment to sustainability.



Posidonia was the first exhibition in Greece to receive the certification in 2022.



Digitalisation of communication

Posidonia radically reduced its print material, replacing it with digital means in all aspects of Posidonia operations - from sales to stand design & construction and all communication channels.

Choosing suppliers with certifications contributes to event's sustainability and quality, e.g., ISO 14001 on Environmental Management Systems, ISO 22000 on Food Safety Management.

Health, Safety, Quality & Environment (HSQE) Achievements of Posidonia 2024



91% of exhibitors appointed **local stand contractors,** thus reducing logistics costs and further supporting the local economy



Maintained **low consumption levels per visitor,** both in electricity (10.2kwh) and water (0.022m³) consumption, despite 12.6% increase in visitor attendance



44% of exhibitors plan to **use the same stand** again in upcoming events



Minimized paper and plastic waste




Zero incident: all safety measures **ensured safe operations** during construction & dismantling






