

POSIDONIA 2022 CONFERENCES SET THE COURSE TO NAVIGATE TUMULTUOUS TIMES

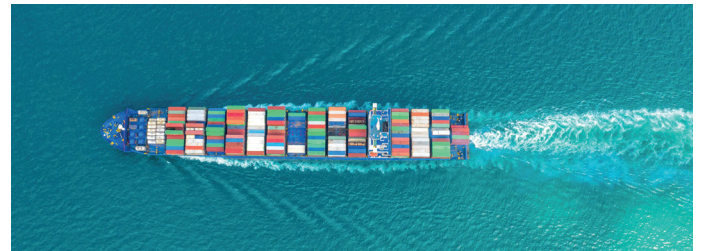

Although there is a 45,8% increase in numbers of women seafarers since 2015, the statistics underline that women are massively underrepresented as seafaring professionals. This is a major issue that needs to be addressed."

This year's version of the **YES to Shipping Forum** will offer students, graduates and young maritime executives the opportunity to meet and interact with exhibiting companies at Posidonia 2022 and also attend a panel discussion about career opportunities in the shipping industry. **Danae Bezantakou, Concept Founder**, said: "We are honored to have been organising the YES to Shipping Forum at Posidonia since 2016. 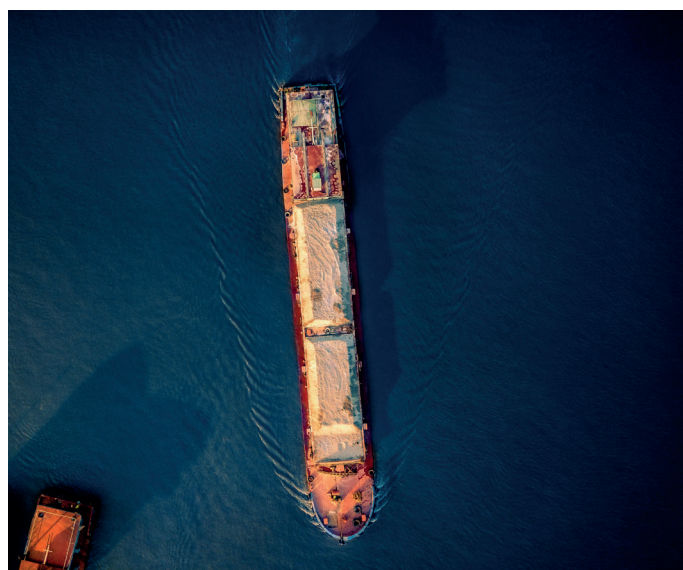

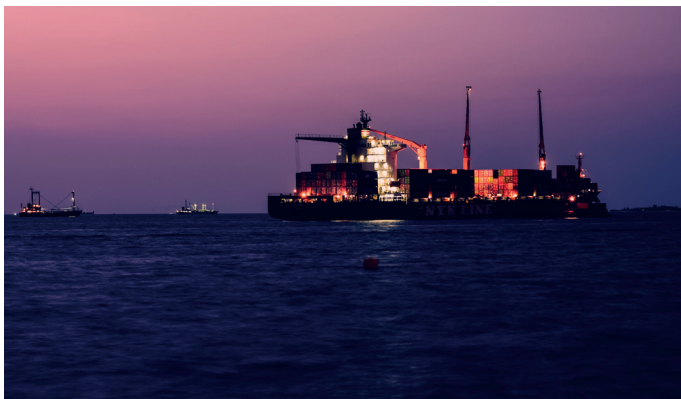

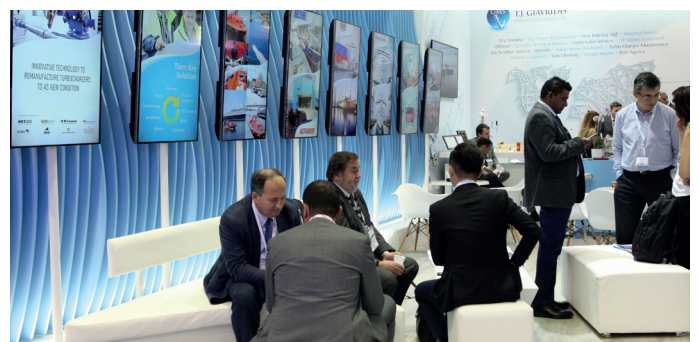

BEGINNER'S LUCK

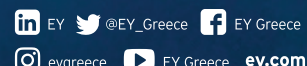
