



KPLER GOES BIG AT POSIDONIA



GROUNDBREAKING DRONE TECHNOLOGY AT POSIDONIA 2024

A brand-new concept in the maritime inspection process will be showcased at Posidonia 2024 by Swiss drone maker **Flyability**. On its Posidonia debut, the Lausanne-based company will present its latest payload for its Elios 3 drone. The Ultrasonic Thickness (UT) payload was developed in partnership with Cygnus Instruments and it turns the Elios 3 into a flying UT measurement gauge that can take accurate thickness measurements backed up with high-resolution A-scans in the most challenging areas. The drone is designed to fly in confined spaces, making it ideal for tank or ballast inspections, where it can gather visual, UT and LiDAR data simultaneously. At the show, the company will perform demos of the drone flying up to several test points and taking UT measurements and explain how it can be used for periodical ship inspections. "With the Elios 3 UT Payload, we have a product that can bring maritime inspections to a whole new level of efficiency, safety and speed, all in compliance with maritime standards," said **Fabio Fata, Sales Manager**. "Posidonia 2024 will witness a revolution in the way maritime inspections are conducted." Flyability has already a significant customer base in Greece.


HNHS USHERS IS A NEW ERA IN NAVIGATION TECHNOLOGIES

The Hellenic Navy Hydrographic Service (HNHS) is charting its course towards a seventh Posidonia participation where it plans to create public awareness about its work and services, network with shipping executives and inform the industry about new standards, protocols and related technologies that will come into effect from 2026 to enable the shift from simple Electronic Navigational Charts (ENCs) to digital geo-information systems. ENCs will have a direct effect on shipping, facilitating decarbonisation and environmental protection and increasing the safety of navigation. HNHS is the official hydrographic organisation of Greece. It is a governmental agency that has exclusive competence and certification to draw up, publish, supplement and correct the official navigational charts of Greece, both printed and electronic and their updates, as well as to publish, supplement and correct official nautical publications. HNHS collects, processes and uses information and data to generate products and services related to Hydrography, Naval Cartography, Marine and Military Oceanography. Lastly, the HNHS is the National Coordinator for the management and operation of NAVTEX Service, in accordance with national and international law and practice.
