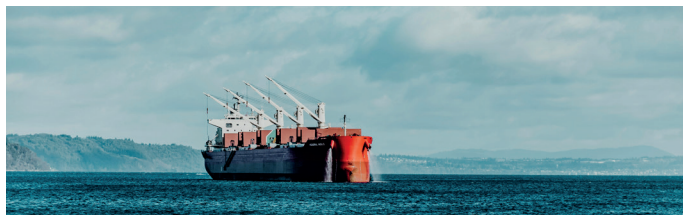


## SB SUNBO TARGETS CLEAN-FUEL PROJECTS AT POSIDONIA 2026

## TURKISH SHIPYARD TO PROMOTE EXPANDED REPAIR CAPACITY

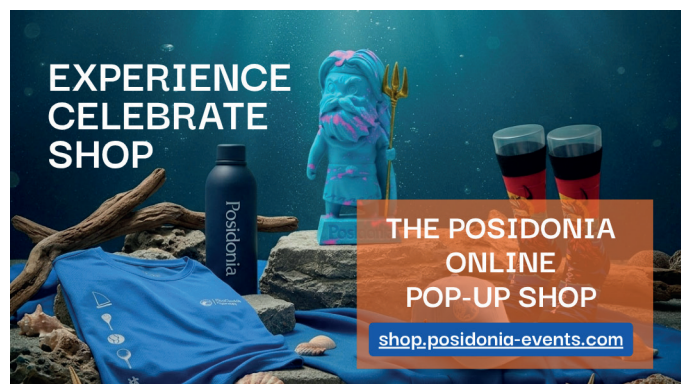

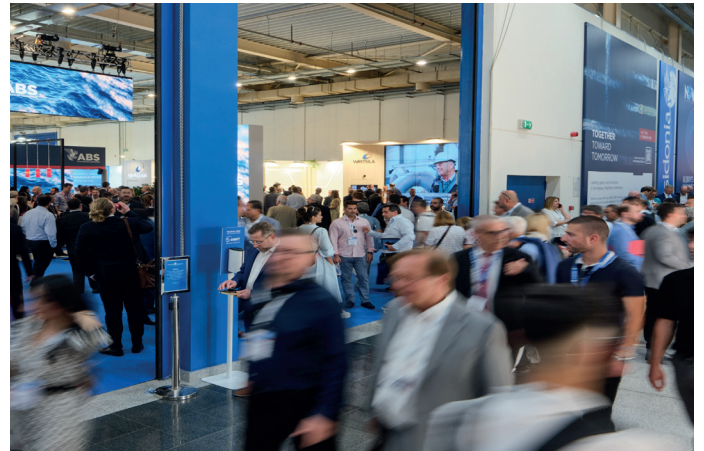
